## User Experience Does Matter

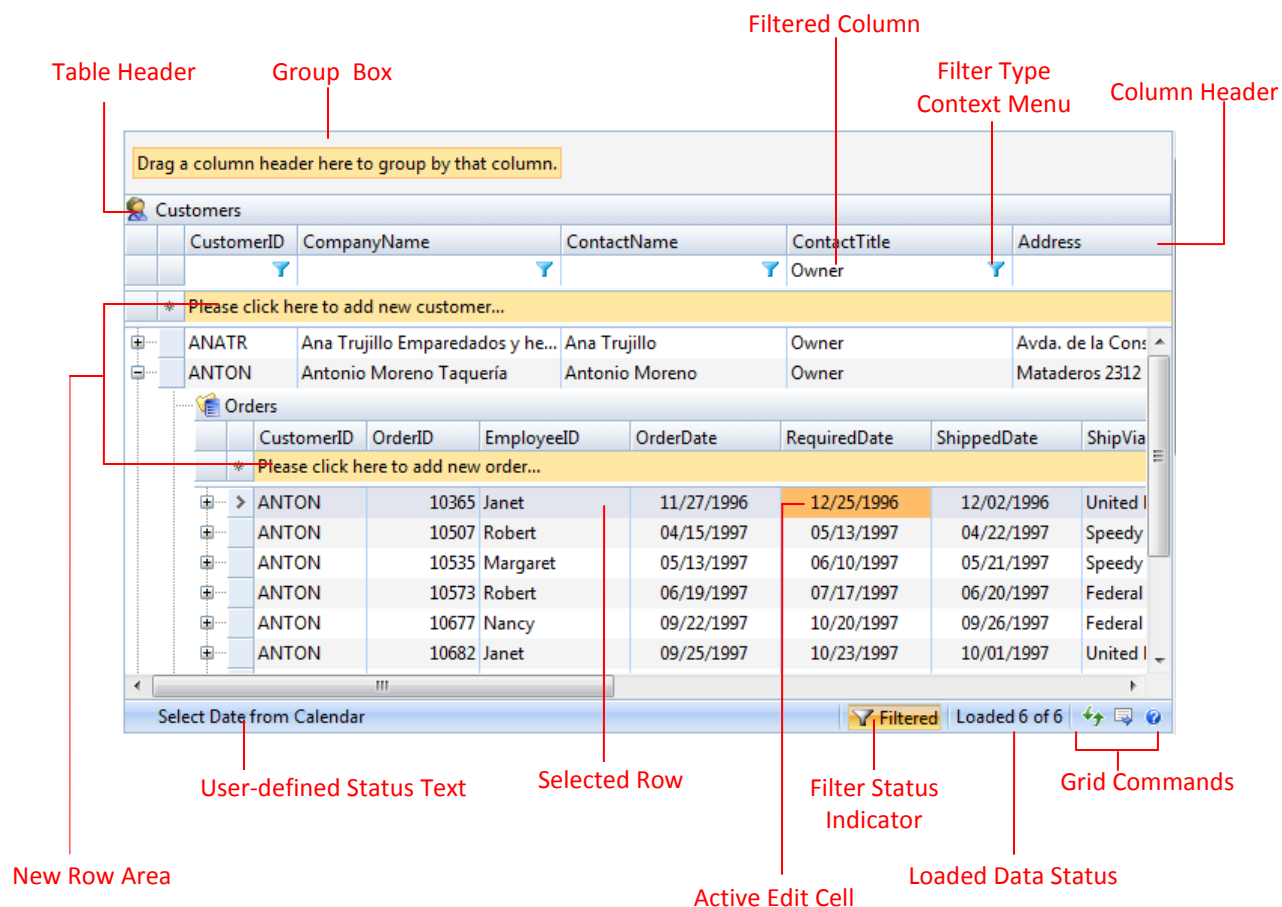

## User Interface Overview

The following image shows the complete user interface elements provided by WebGrid. The WebGrid in the following used the new *Elegant DefaultStyle* that introduced in version 5.0.



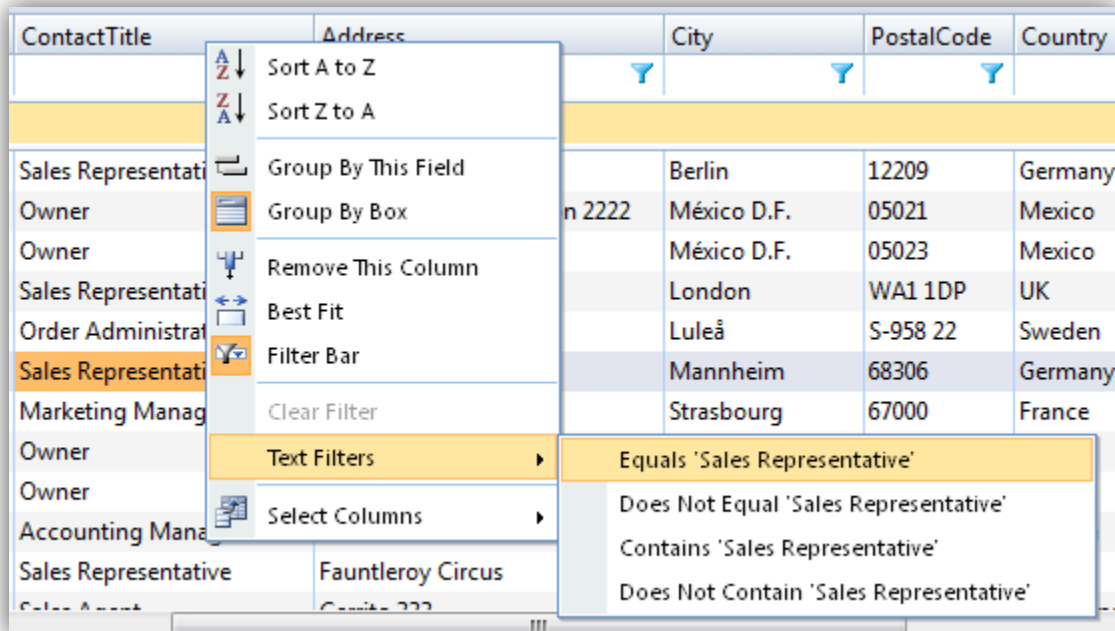
As you can see in above image, WebGrid.NET Enterprise® offers comprehensive user interface elements which significantly enhance user experience in overall while interacting with information. The above image also shows *Hierarchical Drill Down* feature which allows you to easily show drill-down reports. The best part is that all the user interface elements are provided out-of-the-box. You can easily enable or disable certain features by simply setting a property.

Some common user interactions include drag and drop feature, where you can drag a column header to the Group Box area, or drag a column to move its position as well as column resizing.

## New User Experiences

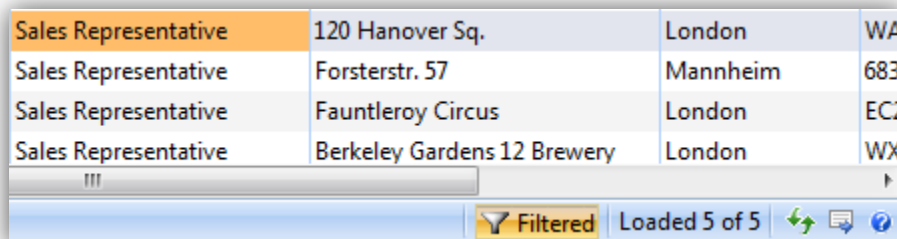

### Automatic Filter Suggestion



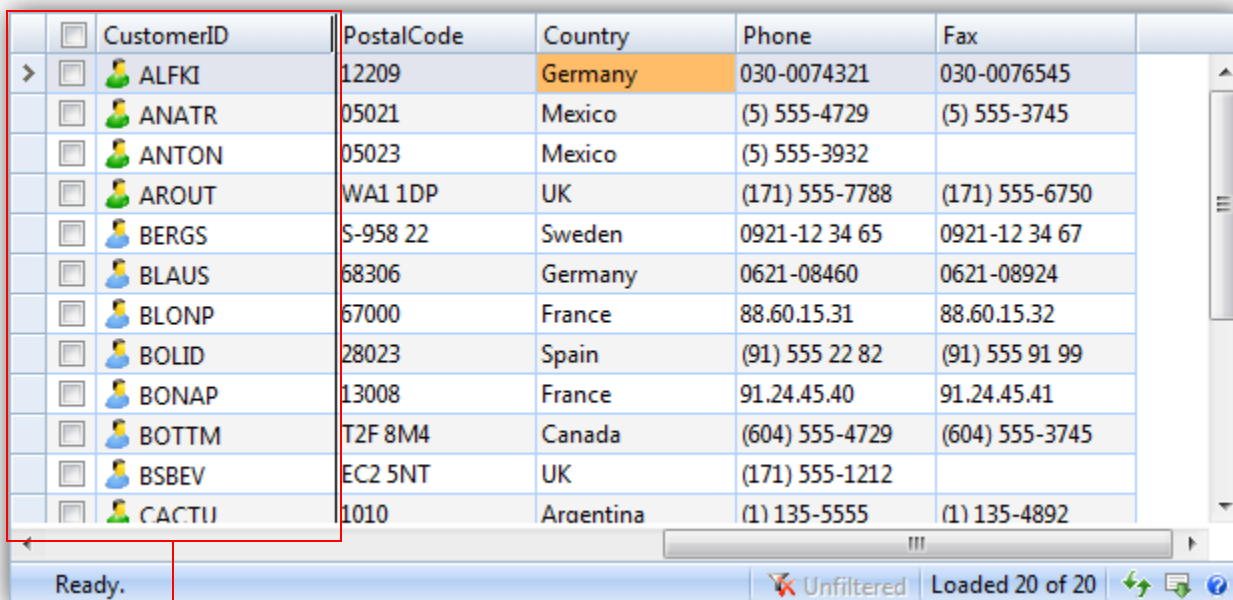
*Automatic Filter Suggestion* is an innovative feature that improve user experience in the way user perform data filtering. As seen in the above image, you can simply right click on a cell which data you wish to filter, then conveniently point your mouse to Text Filters and select one of the filter type that available to the selected cell's data type. With this feature, users can perform data filtering faster and more convenient than ever before.

### Filter Status Indicator



When filtered, the *Filter Status Indicator* will be shown as active style. You can click on the Filter Status Indicator to temporary disable the filters, and click it again to view last filtered data. This feature enhances user experience by allowing them to understand the current state of data and ability to easily toggle the filter status.

Three first columns are frozen.

[Column freezing](#) feature is probably the most wanted feature in every data presentation application. It is useful to keep important information visible when the Grid's view is scrolled to the right end. In the above image, you can see that the *checkbox* and *CustomerID* column are always visible regardless of the horizontal scrollbar position.

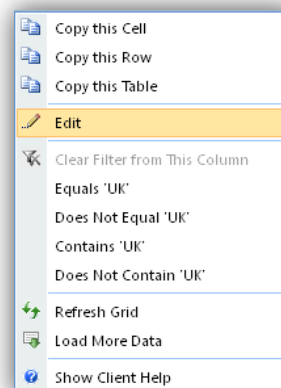
The unique column freezing implementation in WebGrid.NET Enterprise<sup>®</sup> 5.0 – called *LiveFreeze™* – dramatically improves user experience in the way user discovering and analyzing information. It reduces the needs to scroll back and forth by having important information always visible in the view.

LiveFreeze™ redefines a new standard in user experience by introducing Microsoft® Office Excel® column freezing behavior, which is called as [Absolute Scrolling](#). LiveFreeze™ also allow users to [perform freezing and unfreezing at runtime](#) without the need of postback or callback.

## Improved Context Menu Engine

The Context Menu engine in version 5.0 is rewritten from scratch to support more advanced contextual menu system in the WebGrid's user interface. The context menu engine is now based on [Hybrid Menu System™](#) which is the company's proprietary high performance menu system.

With dozens of new commands addition, you can now find the new context menu more intuitive and faster than ever before.



## Enhanced Editing Environment

WebGrid.NET Enterprise® has been famous with its sophisticated in-cell editing environment since the first released version. In its fifth generation, WebGrid includes tremendous enhancements to the editing environment. This section will list what those enhancements are, and how it can improve user experiences during editing.

### Smoother and sleeker edit style

The new edit style helps user to perform data entry more conveniently and with more confident. Its spacious box allows the edit text to have exactly the same boundary as the original cell, making a better data editing experience.

The new built-in *Required Input* feature in version 5.0 makes it very easy for you to add data validation process during editing.

When the cell is empty, the update to the row will be blocked. Next, the error indicator will appear in the right end of the cells which require user input. A warning indicator will

also appear in the status bar area enabling user to easily understand the current state of the data input.

### Verbose Editing Text

This feature improves data editing experience by displaying verbose information associated to the selected cell in the status bar area. Displaying related information during editing helps user to provide accurate information and therefore
